CAMERA BASICS WITH CHRIS LUSE

Bring your camera and learn about your camera from the inside out. Including how to properly expose a photograph and how to best use settings for your best photo.



ACTION CLASS WITH RON HAYES

Action photography encompasses all manner of capturing motion creatively. From athletics to birds in flight, we will cover how to perfect your action photography.



CRITIQUE CLASS
