



## REGISTRATION FORM

- Please review team requirements and rules.
- Send the completed registration form to [jgoodwin@candowyoing.com](mailto:jgoodwin@candowyoing.com) or return to 130 S 3rd Street, Douglas, WY 82633.
- Teams must check in at the Enterprise vendor booth registration table by 11:30am on race day.
- First heat begins racing at noon, down S 3rd Street following a team safety meeting with all racers.
- Each team gets 5 minutes to make their bed prior to the start of their race.
- ALL team members must sign a waiver prior to the race.
- Once registered, the team captain listed below will receive the bed race rules and regulations and any additional information regarding the race.
- You are welcome to build and race your own bed racer, contact Jen Goodwin for bed racer specifications. Otherwise, there are 3 bed racers provided.

## REGULATIONS

All rules, regulations, and time schedules must be adhered to and are in place for everyone's safety. Failure to observe the rules and/or the instructions from Race Officials may result in your team's disqualification from the race. Each team member must complete the waiver of liability and registration form. **Registration deadline is 11:00 am on June 8, 2024.** -The Enterprise Bed Racing Committee

## THE BED RACER TEAM

- A team must have five (3) participants or members. One (1) person must ride the bed, and the other four (2) other team members push the bed.
- The same 3 people must be used in each heat throughout the competition. A team may have an alternate member who can be a substitute runner or rider in case of injury.
- Use of a helmet is recommended for the rider (passenger). Everyone's safety is a primary goal of the race.
- Team pushers **cannot have flip-flops, sandals, or bare feet.**
- At least one of the team members must be 18 years of age or older. Consent of a parent or guardian is required for anyone between 12-17 years of age.
- All participants must follow the instructions of the Race Officials.
- Teams must arrive 20 minutes before the scheduled start time for the team safety meeting.
- Teams will get 5 mins to make their bed before the race.
- Each participant must sign a waiver form on the day of the race, including alternate members.
- The bed must be made with at least a blanket and a pillow. Teams are encouraged to decorate their beds and get creative.
- The team's name is encouraged to be displayed on the bed.
- Bed racers are provided for the races. Each team will either draw a bed number, flip a coin, or have the option to bid, to determine which bed racer is used.

## WHAT TO EXPECT DURING THE BED RACE

- The course is a straight path down a stretch of S. 3rd Street.
- The beds will be raced in heats (two at a time). Double or single elimination will be based on the number of entries.
- Each team must start the race from a still (stopped) position. Teammates cannot use a running start across the start line, and they cannot rock the bed back and forth in time with “On your mark, get set, go!”
- The bed and/or runners cannot cross the centerline of the racecourse. Must do your best to remain in your lane.
- Team members cannot interfere with their opponents in any way during the race.
- The point of the bed that extends the furthest in the front will be aligned with the starting line (not necessarily the front wheels) to compensate for differences in bed construction. The same front point will be used to judge the finish.
- The two judges standing at the finish line will determine the winner of each heat.
- Each team member and alternate member must sign a waiver of liability before the start of the race.
- Each entry that decorates their bed will be judged for a special prize. Get creative and have fun!
